JUST 4 KILOMETERS AWAY FROM THE TOWN ITSELF.

CTV'S REGAN HASEGAWA HAS MORE.
>> WATER BOMBERS AND HELICOPTERS ARE BUCKETING THE RAPIDLY RACING FIRES, IT CROSSED THE U.S.-CANADA BORDER SATURDAY AND PUSHED CLOSER TO TOWN DUE TO STRONG WINDS.

>> IT'S IMPRESSIVE, IT'S SCARY, BUT IT'S -- IT'S FASCINATING TO WATCH HOW FAST IT MOVES AND THEN HOW YOU WILL BE WATCHING IT AND THEN ABOUTH 100 METERS AHEAD, A SPARK WILL HAPPEN AND ANOTHER TREE WILL GO UP AND THEN THE MAIN BULK OF THE FIRE CAMPS UP TO THAT AND IT WAS MOVING SO FAST NORTH.

>> OUR NUMBER ONE PRIORITY IS THE FOCUS ON THAT EAST SIDE WHICH CLOSE TO WHERE THAT ORDER HAS BEEN PUT IN PLACE.

THE FIRST PRIORITY'S ALWAYS HUMAN LIFE AND SAFETY AND THEN YOU GET INTO PROPERTIES AND THEN YOU GET INTO ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES AND THEN THE TIMBER VALUES.

>> MORE THAN 730 PROPERTIES HAVE BEEN ORDERED OUT OF THE AREA.

ANOTHER 2100 ARE ON ALERT. THE HEART OF WINE COUNTRY TYPICALLY TEEMING WITH TOURISTS NOW UNDER A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY.

>>> PRIME MINISTER JUSTIN TRUDEAU TODAY WELCOMING NEWS THAT A NEW TENTATIVE FREE TRADE AGREEMENT HAS BEEN REACHED IN THE ONGOING BC PORT LABOUR DISPUTE.

>> WHAT WE NOW HAVE A SITUATION WHERE THERE IS ANOTHER OFFER, THERE IS ANOTHER POTENTIAL DEAL ON THE TABLE AND WE'RE, AS ALWAYS, HOPEFUL THAT THAT NEGOTIATION AT THE BARGAINING TABLE CONTINUES TO BE AT THE CENTRE OF WHAT EVERY DAVID NEEDS TO CONTINUE TO DO.

>> DETAILS OF THE DEAL HAVE NOT BEEN RELEASED YET, BUT THE LONGSHORE WORKERS UNION AND THE EMPLOYERS ASSOCIATION IS BOTH RECOMMENDING UNION MEMBERS RATIFY IT.

PRESSURE HAD BEEN MOUNTING ON THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO INTERVENE IF NO DEAL COULD BE REACHED.

>> A STRIKE BY SOME 3700 WORKERS AT 27 METRO GROCERY STORES IN THE TORONTO AREA IS ENTERING ITS THIRD DAY.

>> I CAN'T AFFORD TO, LIKE, PAY MY STUDENT LOAN.

I CAN'T AFFORD TO PAY RENT.

AND THAT'S RIDICULOUS, EVEN IF I CAN SHOP AT METRO, WHAT'S THE POINT OF WORKING FOR A COMPANY THAT CAN'T PAY ME.

>> WORKERS WALKED OFF THE JOB AT MIDNIGHT ON SATURDAY AFTER THEY REJECTED A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT.

THE UNION'S NATIONAL PRESIDENT SAYS THAT THE AGREEMENT DID NOT PROPERLY ADDRESS THE DETERIORATING WORKING CONDITIONS IN GROCERY STORES.

AFFECTED STORES WILL BE CLOSED FOR THE DURATION OF THE STRIKE.

PHARMACY ALSO, HOWEVER, WILL REMAIN OPEN.

THE STRIKING METRO GROCERY WORKERS ARE CALLING FOR INCREASED WAGES, STABLE WORKING HOURS AND JOB SECURITY.

>> RIGHT, THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF OKANAGAN SIMILKAMEEN OPERATION CENTRE IS OFFERING AN UPDATE.

>> EMERGENCY.ORDOS.BC.ca A. IF WE'RE ABLE TO ZOOM IN A BIT MORE, YOU CAN SEE THAT THE EVACUATION ORDER AREA HAS CHANGED ALONG WITH THE ALERT AREA.

THE RDOSC AND THE TOWN OF OSOYOOS EMERGENCY CENTRE HAVE REMOVED THE EVACUATION ORDER FOR MOST OF THE TOWN OF OSOYOOS AND AREAS WITHIN THE RDOS SOUTH OF THE TOWN OF OSOYOOS.

THESE PROPERTIES REMAIN ON EVACUATION ALERT DUE TO THE EAGLE BLUFF WILDFIRE.

AGAIN, THE ORDER AREA AS YOU CAN SEE FROM THAT MAP HAS CHANGED.

THAT AREA, THOUGH, WILL REMAIN ON EVACUATION ALERT.

PROPERTIES REMAINING UNDER
EVACUATION ORDER AND THAT'S FOR

THE TOWN OF OSOYOOS.

THE NUMBERS NOW ARE AT 2,635,
THAT'S 2,635 PROPERTIES REMAIN
UNDER EVACUATION ALERT.

AND 245 INVOLVES ELECTORAL AREAS
(a) AND(b) AND THE TOWN OF
OSOYOOS AND I HAVE TO CLARIFY
WHETHER ELECTORAL AREA (c) WAS
INVOLVED STILL BECAUSE THERE WAS
A PORTION BUT WE CAN CLARIFY
THAT.

FLANK DAMAR HAMLIN IS BOTH SIDES
OF THE FIRE THAT'S CLOSER IN
PROXIMITY TO THIS CITY. THIS IS
WHERE IT WILL HAVE A MAJORITY OF
OUR HEAVY EQUIPMENT AND
PERSONNEL CONTINUE TO WORK.
SO WE HAVE 50 FIREFIGHTERS
